

Barkz Playground Safety Rules

- All dogs must be current on all vaccinations; our Barkz staff will send you a friendly reminder if an update is needed.
- Dogs must have leashes, harnesses and collars removed for their safety.
- All dogs must be spayed or neutered when old enough to play in the playground.
- Treats are not allowed during playgroups. You never know if a dog will become possessive of food even if they have never been before, it can happen when there is high energy in the room.
- If a dog guards a toy, playground supervisors will promptly remove that toy or toys from the room.
- Play sessions are reserved on a first come first served basis, if you want to guarantee a place for you and your dog please make sure you have let Barkz know ahead of time. Walk-ins will be accepted if we have the room.
- Owners are required during play sessions to clean up after their pet if accidents occur. Playground supervisors need to watch the room and play at all times.
- Children are welcome to attend play sessions; they should not be fearful or overly inclined to want to play with the dogs in the room. This is the dog's playtime with furry friends.
- Chairs are available but are not out if an owner sits the dog will be less inclined to play or other dogs will end up in your lap.
- Playground Supervisor reserves the right to ask a dog or child to leave the play area if the behaviors are causing other dogs stress.
